Características de las pruebas

Written exam (90 %) that will include:

- Vocabulary exercises (matching elements, filling gaps from a list of words, combining elements in a definition)
- Writing exercises (creating simple descriptions and comparisons of visual elements)
- Reading exercises (saying if a statement about a text is true or false and finding the part that proves it)
- Translation exercises (giving an approximate Spanish equivalent of short English texts related to our technical area)

A short oral interview (10%) that will simulate an interview with the student about their work experience, the graphic techniques they know, their studies and their ambitions. More than perfect grammar or pronunciation, the main focus will be on communicative ability.
